By joining as one voice and one family once a year, we will reinforce our connection among our people.

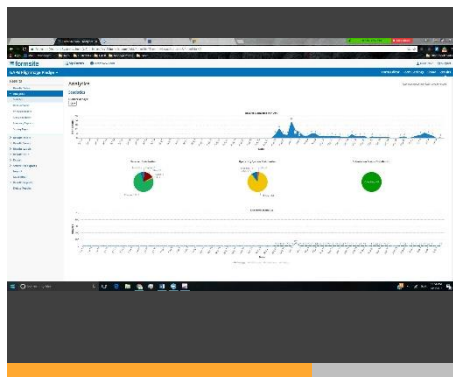
Purpose

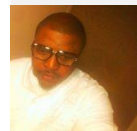

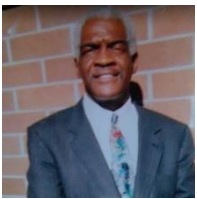
Bill Gates stated that Africa has the most potential because it has the youngest population. So we will target this population by educating them on specific trades and know how that could sold on a Global Markets.

You have to see the urgency for doing for ourselves for our people with the understand that it is already being done by white people in Africa that we have us working for them once again if we do not realize this for ourselves.



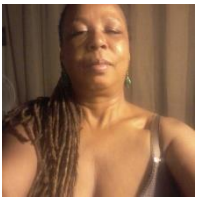
